TO SCREEN for patients likely to lose their eyes to Childhood refractive error, Glaucoma Diabetic Retinopathy...... and other eye diseases

What facilities are available on the Mobile Eye Clinic??

The mobile eye clinic has the following state of the art equipments

1. Auto refractometer:

To check for eye number

2. Tonometer:

To check for eye pressure

3. Fundus camera:

To check Retina

4. Green laser:

For treating certain Retinal conditions

(for representative purpose only)

How will a typical outreach program function?

On finalizing the date,

The eye van will reach the site by 10 am. On an average, 100 patients can be screened in one day. The chief optometrist of the outreach program will carry out the screening program along with the help of one helper from the eye hospital and local volunteers



Those having eye number, will be given prescription for glasses

Those that need surgeries, will be referred to either Sahu eye hospital or the closest charitable eye hospital
